Report of the Annual Student Survey 2017





Preface

An annual student survey was conducted during the 2–tier induction programme for post-graduate students, initiated by the IQAC in 2017. This was aimed at understanding the student cohort's social, academic, entrepreneurial, and aspirational background, so as to enable the teachers and administrators to serve them better. 81 questions were asked under 9 heads. The responses to these are now compiled and presented in this report. This is the third time that the survey is being published.

481 students of the new admission have taken part in this survey, making it a fairly representative one. The annual conduct of this survey is expected to also provide an indication of changing social backgrounds and student population.

I am sure that all stake-holders of the University system will find this report of immense relevance and use. Suggestions for improvement are welcome.
