Item No.Q3.7.03: <u>Curriculum Fair</u>:- As an innovation in academics, it is proposed that a curriculum fair be held to bring to visibility best practices in curriculum design and transaction. It is ideal to hold this jointly with Department of Education of University of Kerala. Discussions have been held with Head, Dept. of Education and Dean, Faculty of Education. Both of them have agreed to the idea. As a beginning, it can be held in a small scale with teachers of University Departments and Affiliated Colleges invited to take part and display posters on unique curriculum design and transaction practices. The IQAC may advice action.

Item No.Q3.7.04: <u>Linnaeus – Palme Program With Lund University</u>: The Linnaeus- Palme International academic exchange programme between the Department of Communication and Journalism, University of Kerala and the Department of Media and Communication, Lund University has commenced. Ms. Josephin Wennang and Mr. Oscar Schau, media students from Lund University have begun their three months study programme at DCJ, University of Kerala, India. Both are working on specific research areas focusing on Kerala Society and Media. An induction function and an interactive session with the Swedish students were arranged at DCJ. The Master students of Mass Communication had a vibrant interaction with the visiting Swedish students on the occasion.Dr. Mia Marie Hammarlin, Senior Lecturer of KOM, Lund University will visit University of Kerala for a three week teaching assignment under the same project in December 2015. Ms. Anju Jacob and Ms.Parvathy Vijayan, both Master students at the DCJ, will represent University of Kerala as the Linnaeus- Palme students for a three months study in Lund University from Next January onward. Dr. M.S Harikumar will be the Linnaeus-Palme faculty fellow from the University of Kerala during that period.

Item No.Q3.7.05: <u>Consultancy Brochure for the University</u>:- University of Kerala at present has only a handful of consultancy works. There is a need to enhance this to promote consultancy activities of the University; a consultancy brochure may be prepared

Decision:It was resolved that University Consultancy Cell may organize a seminar to enhance consultancy efforts, in collaboration with IQAC.

Item No.Q3.7.06: <u>Proposal for offering Psychological Services</u>:- Psychological services to be offered can fall into three main areas, namely, counselling, testing, and training. Psychological counselling would include providing help to a troubled student. Psychological testing would be done on certain psychological variables like intelligence, personality, and other such that would provide an insight to the students. Psychological training would include equipping the students with certain psychological skills that would help them to lead a better and successful life.

The first two services can be provided on a weekly basis, where a psychologist can be made available in the campus. This, if possible, can be done with the cooperation of the Department of Psychology, University of Kerala. Teachers, research scholars, and students of the department can offer these services.

The third service i.e., training can be done on a monthly or semester basis, where the students can be trained on certain psychological skills like interpersonal skills, emotional intelligence, stress management, confidence building etc. For this, external resource persons can be contacted.

Before offering these services, it is necessary that the students be made aware of the importance and need of seeking psychological help. The stigma associated with seeking psychological help need to be eliminated so that the students would make use of the opportunity. For this, psychologists can be brought to the campus to speak to the students. This can be easily done during the induction programmes organized.

Interaction with psychologists can be included in the induction programmes at the university, school, and department levels. During this interaction, it should be communicated to the students about the different psychological services offered and the need for such services. Thus, the whole process can take place broadly in two stages. First is the awareness creation stage, where students are made aware about the need for the psychological services centre and its functions. Second is the psychological service proper, where qualified psychologists are made available for psychological counselling, testing, and training, as per the need.

Decision: Resolved to refer the matter to the HOD, Dept. of Psychology for remarks.

Item No.Q3.7.07: Status of eBook Project:- Vide item Q3.3.08; IQAC had approved the eBook series. A circular and poster has been issued to all departments and 12 entries have been received. Some samples are placed before IQAC, for information. It is expected that the books can be finalised in December & released on-line.

Decision: It was resolved that the Vice-Chancellor be authorised to form an Editorial Board to ensure quality of publications, and the editorial board may refer the books for peer review, as it deems fit.

Item No.Q3.7.08: <u>Facebook Page for University:</u> In master action plan approved by IQAC it was resolved that the University web presence should be extended to social media, Facebook and Twitter. On a trial basis, a Face book page can be launched under direct supervision of Director, IQAC. It shall initially consist of 3 kinds of posts.

- (a) Key information from press release.
- (b) Photographs of events like seminars etc. related to the day.
- (c) Curio information, scenic photographs, historic photographs etc. related to University. IQAC may give approval for the proposal.

Item No. Q.3.7.09: Quality Consultation Meeting with Faculty:- A quality consultation meeting with all faculty members of the University was held in 7/9/2015. The minutes are given in Appendix. It was an opportunity to get critical feedback and constructive suggestions. The matter is reported to the IQAC.

Item No.Q3.7.10: <u>Graduate Attributes Video & Booklet</u>:- The Graduate Attributes Video that was screened during 3-tier Induction Programme has now been redone with some changes. Its content has also been put in the form of a booklet. Both the video CD and booklet will be tabled in the meeting.

Item No.Q3.7.11: Progress of Multi-Disciplinary Annual Research Conference (MARC): As per earlier decision of IQAC, Multi -Disciplinary Annual Research Conference (MARC) 2015 will be organized during 15-18 December 2015. There will be a common inaugural and plenary session to be organized in the University Senate Hall on Tuesday the 15th of December 2015. It will be followed by school level conferences organized in various academic schools. For discussing the steps for the conference, meetings of all Heads and School Directors were convened in the Senate Chamber twice. Besides the central organising committee met twice in the department of Bio-informatics. All the schools except the School of Distance Education have finalised their conferences and prepared brochures calling papers. A common brochure was also prepared and uploaded in the website. Information regarding the conferences was published in the newspapers and general brochure prepared for calling papers were sent to many academic institutions by mail as well as by post. The conference will be inaugurated by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. Guests of honour for the inaugural and plenary session was finalised and their confirmation of arrival obtained. The resource persons for the plenary session include Padma Shri. Y.S Rajan, Sri.T.M Krishna, Sri. P.Radhakrishnan and Dr. Sebastian Paul. The committee also finalised the mode of implementation of the conference and various sub committees were formed for the purpose. Common Certificates for the participants and paper presenters will be prepared and distributed to the schools. The preparation for the conference is in the final stage. Poster and brochure are appended.




