REPORT OF THE DEPARTMENT LEVEL INDUCTION PROGRAMME IN GEOLOGY on 27-09-2018, Thursday @ 10am

The department level induction programme was held in the seminar hall of the department. The Head of the department Dr R.B. Binoj Kumar gave the introductory remarks. Followed by a detailed session by Dr. S.N. Kumar, the Director of School of earth system sciences who is also the Director of Placement Cell University of Kerala. He spoke on geological aspects as well as carrier prospects. Then the other faculty members Dr. Sajinkumar, Dr. Anil Kumar, Dr. Shaji, Dr. Pradeepkumar and Dr Rajesh Reghunath interacted with the students in the order given. Since the faculty members of our department Dr. Sajinkumar and Dr. Anil Kumar came from the Geological Survey of India, Ministry of Mines,

Government of India, they spoke in details regarding the geological setup and job prospects of the country. Dr. Pradeepkumar talked to the students regarding the ore resources of India. Dr. Shaji (who is also previously worked in the Central Groundwater Board, Ministry of Water Resources, Government of India) highlighted the groundwater conditions and also on the recent floods in Kerala. Dr Sajinkumar who was an expert member of the team from Michigen Technological University USA, visited the landslide sites of the recent floods, talked to students on the landslide and affected areas. In addition to that an interaction with the parents was also held on the admission day. The parents and students who got admission on 25-09-2018 were assembled in the seminar hall of the department and the faculty members interacted with them and cleared all the doubts the parents has.

The afternoon session on 27-09-2018 was totally earmarked for the visit to various laboratories in the department, Dr. Anil Kumar Y., the course coordinator of S1 batch accompanied the students. The students visited labs and got familiarized with the modern equipments available in the department. After that the students were allowed to visit the geology museum in the department which has got a detailed collection of rocks and minerals. The talk was on the title" Fibre Optics Technology". The first part of the session focused on the requirements of the industry/consumer and the latest fibre optic technologies used in communication industry to feed the bandwidth hunger of the consumer. The second part of the session described the optical amplification procedure and future scope for expansion. Finally a session on the current trends and technology was provided to mould an insight about the industry. Session ended with vote of thanks by one among the students.



The second session was handled by Dr K.B. Jinesh. The session began with an introductory speech by Dr. A. Yamuna, Assistant Professor of the Department. The talk was titled" Intellectual Property Rights and Patents". The session initially dealt with intellectual property and the requirement of protecting them. The speaker introduced different terms like trademark, copyright and patents. Later in the session, the procedure to file a patent application and obtaining a patent was discussed. Comparative analysis on organic and inorganic electronics components were given for an intricate view of the current trend and future scope of the technology in the industry. The second level induction programme was organized by Department of Biotechnology on 04th September 2018 for the new batch of MSc. Students (2018- 2020 batch). The new students(15 No's) were welcomed by Dr. A. Jayakumaran Nair, Head, Department of Biotechnology. He also welcomed the speaker to the programme. He talked about the importance and major aspects of the course in his welcome speech. This was followed by an official talk by the speaker, Dr. P.R. Sudhakaran, Former Professor & Head, Department of Biochemistry, University of Kerala, and Thiruvananthapuram. In his talk, he stressed on the 'Molecular philosophy in Science'. He suggested that there was a paradigm shift in the approach to study Biology earlier which led to the emergence of new technologies that led to the development of Biotechnology and also the molecularization of biology had tremendous societal advantages. He enlightened the students by briefing them the history of Biotechnology, various compound discoveries, identifying the mode of infectious diseases, natural products as protective agents, and also on new technologies to manipulate gene and gene products. He talked on the importance of Biotechnology and its significant contributions to different fields of Science and also its favourable societal implications. He advocated the students to 'Take a Constant Decision and not a Chance Decision'. He also advised the students to get more number of elective courses apart from the core course in order to explore more and more areas and also to make use of the campus atmosphere favourably. The students

enthusiastically listened to the talk. Finally Dr. Supriya R., Lecturer, Department of Biotechnology thanked the speaker and audience and the programme came to an end by 12.00 pm.
